ORDER AFFIRMING PLANNING BOARD DECISION. WITH CONDITIONS

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, after review of the administrative record, that the decision of the Planning Board in PGCPB No. 13-128, to approve with conditions a detailed site plan for approval of a contractor's storage yard in the Light Industrial (I-1) Zone, located in the southeast quadrant of the intersection of Prosperity Way and Prosperity Court, within Council District 7, Planning Area 75B, of the Developed Tier, is:

AFFIRMED, subject to the District Council's original jurisdiction pursuant to §27-132(f)(1) of the Zoning Ordinance and its authority to modify the decision of the Planning Board pursuant to 27-290(d) of the Zoning Ordinance.

As the basis for this action, the District Council, pursuant to §27-132(f)(1) and §27-290 of the Zoning Ordinance, adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the Planning Board in its Resolution, PGCPB No. 13-128.

Affirmance of the Planning Board's decision is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to certification, the applicant shall revise the detailed site plan (DSP) to:
 - a. Revise the tree canopy coverage schedule to reflect the number and type of proposed trees.
 - b. Change both proposed shrub types to native species as required by the 2010 Prince George's County Landscape Manual.
 - Clearly show and label the ten-foot-wide public utility easement as c. reflected on the record plat.

2. Prior to issuance of any grading permits, a methane survey shall be completed and submitted to the Environmental Planning Section and the Prince George's County Health Department. If methane is encountered on-site, a mitigation plan shall be required for the development. All required remediation activities shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Health Department prior to issuance of any grading permit.
