
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GENERAL LOCATION MAP






SITE VICINITY MAP



ZONING MAP


Property Zone: ROS




AERIAL MAP

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

1. During the construction phase, the applicant should adhere to the State of Maryland Regulations regarding particulate matter pollution and noise.

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- 2. Signage for the proposed project should be compatible with the surrounding neighborhoods.
- 3. Consider screening mechanical equipment from the residential homes and public rights-of-way adjacent to and abutting the site, to the extent practical.
- 4. The applicant is encouraged to utilize green building techniques in the building construction, to the extent practical.
- 5. Prior to issuance of a use and occupancy permit, the applicant and the applicant's heirs, successors, and assignees should contact the Prince George's County Fire/EMS Department to request a pre-incident Emergency Plan for the facility.

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STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS

6. Install and maintain a sprinkler system that complies with the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA 13) Standard for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems.

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- 7. Install and maintain automated external defibrillators (AEDs), in accordance with the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) requirements (COMAR 30.06.01-05), so that any employee is no more than 500 feet from an AED.
- 8. Install and maintain bleeding control kits next to a fire extinguisher installation, which must be no more than 75 feet from any employee.
- 9. Revise the tree conservation plan (TCPII), to reflect the current proposed development prior to permits being issued.

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
