In a letter dated May 24, 2006, the applicant has requested a continuance of the Planning Board hearing for the above-referenced plan, which was previously scheduled for June 8, 2006. The applicant has requested a hearing date of July 6, 2006. The Planning Board 140-day mandatory action time frame expires on July 7, 2006.

The applicant previously waived the 70-day processing period for this application. The continuance is requested to allow the Transportation Section adequate time to review traffic movement counts that were submitted by the applicant.

The application is for a proposed church in the R-35 Zone. A companion detailed site plan has been applied for and is currently scheduled for the Planning Board hearing on July 6, 2006. Therefore, approval of the continuance request would allow the preliminary plan of subdivision and the detailed site plan for this property to be presented to the Planning Board on the same day.

The public hearing notice for this application was posted on May 9, 2006.
