RE: Preliminary Plan # 4-05157, Sanford Property

Staff is recommending that the Planning Board grant a continuance for subdivision case number 4-05157. A staff report was completed and submitted to the Planning Board Commissioners, however, the Water and Sewer categories detailed in the staff report are incorrectly stated as being in Category Three (3). The correct category is Five (5). As such, the Planning Board cannot move forward with the review of the case and staff recommendation of approval with conditions.

The applicant submitted an application to the Department of Environmental Resources for a Water and Sewer Category change to reflect Category Four (4), on August 1, 2006. The County Council has not yet held a legislative hearing for Water and Sewer amendments. Until, this legislative body meets to review and grant the Water and Sewer Category changes no action for approval can occur on this case.

Therefore, staff recommended to the applicant to provide a 70-day waiver and a letter requesting a continuance, both of which were received on October 27, 2006. Staff is in support of a continuance. The granting of the continuance by the Planning Board will allow the applicant additional time necessary to obtain the Water and Sewer category change from the County Council.
