

71A-009b Holy Trinity Episcopal Church Rectory

Built in 1829 to serve as the home of the parish priest, the Holy Trinity Church Rectory is a two-andone-half-story, gable-roof brick dwelling of side-hall-and-double-parlor plan. It has a Tuscan porch, modest early Greek Revival trim, and a later wings, which were demolished in late 2010. (The photograph above shows the wings before they were destroyed.) It is a fine example of an early Greek Revival style brick dwelling and one of only three surviving examples of its type built of brick in Prince George's County.
