

71A-034 Boyden House

6501 Hillmeade Road Bowie vicinity

Built in 1917 — The Boyden House is a 2-1/2-story, side-gabled, stucco-covered frame house of Colonial Revival style that stands on landscaped grounds. It has a Tuscan porch at one end and an enclosed sunporch wing at the other. It was built by local carpenter Millard Schafer for attorney J. Hanson Boyden. One of four fine dwellings in the immediate area built by Schafer, it is an excellent example of early twentieth-century Colonial Revival style.
