

72-006 Carmody House 6808 Drylog Street

Seat Pleasant vicinity

Built in 1895, with several additions in the twentieth century, the Carmody House is a two-and-onehalf-story, cross-gabled frame dwelling that has undergone numerous additions. It was the home of Francis S. Carmody, banker, contractor and developer of the Town of Seat Pleasant. Carmody's house is one of the few remaining examples of turn-of-the-twentieth-century rural residential architecture in the developed tier.
