



86A-004 Brookewood and Cemetery

Built circa 1858, Brookewood is a three-part Greek Revival style frame plantation house of unusual interior plan; it consists of a two-story, front-gabled central block, flanked by two one-and-one-half-story side-gabled wings. On the immediate grounds is a small family burial ground. The house was built for Benjamin H. Eversfield; after the Civil War it was the home of the Wood family. After it was sold in 1953 the owner removed some of the exterior detail, and applied a brick veneer.

Although the exterior has been significantly altered, the interior exhibits fine Victorian decorative detail, and a Greek Revival-period plan unique in Prince George's County.
