Built circa 1855, the house at West End Farm is a two-story, side-gabled frame house of side-hall-and-double-parlor plan; it has two attached lower wings. The boxed returned cornices are decorated with jigsawn modillions, and the interior displays fine decorative detail of the period. The house was built for prominent Upper Marlboro attorney C. C. Magruder and is a good example of the country house of a successful professional man.
