


STANDARD TYPE 2 TREE CONSERVATION PLAN NOTES


- 1. THIS PLAN IS SUBMITTED TO FULFILL THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION REQUIREMENTS FOR TCP2 019-14. IF TCP2 019-14 EXPIRES, THEN THIS TCP2 ALSO EXPIRES AND IS NO LONGER VALID.
- 2. CUTTING OR CLEARING OF WOODLAND NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THIS PLAN OR WITHOUT THE EXPRESSED WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE PLANNING DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A \$9.00 PER SQUARE FOOT MITIGATION FEE.
- 3. A PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF GRADING PERMITS. THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND TRANSPORTATION OR THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, AS APPROPRIATE, SHALL BE CONTACTED PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY WORK ON THE SITE TO CONDUCT A PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING WHERE IMPLEMENTATION OF WOODLAND CONSERVATION MEASURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN WILL BE DISCUSSED IN DETAIL.
- 4. THE DEVELOPER OR BUILDER OF THE LOTS OR PARCELS SHOWN ON THIS PLAN SHALL NOTIFY FUTURE BUYERS OF ANY WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS THROUGH THE PROVISION OF A COPY OF THIS PLAN AT TIME OF CONTRACT SIGNING. FUTURE PROPERTY OWNERS ARE ALSO SUBJECT TO THIS REQUIREMENT.
- 5. THE OWNERS OF THE PROPERTY SUBJECT TO THIS TREE CONSERVATION PLAN ARE SOLELY RESPONSIBLE FOR CONFORMANCE TO THE REQUIREMENTS CONTAINED
- 6. THE PROPERTY IS WITHIN THE DEVELOPING TIER AND IS ZONED R-R.
- 7. THE SITE IS NOT ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY DESIGNATED AS SCENIC, HISTORIC, A PARKWAY OR A SCENIC BYWAY.
- 8. THE SITE IS ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY CLASSIFIED AS ARTERIAL OR GREATER (INDIAN HEAD HIGHWAY, FREEWAY ROADWAY).
- 9. THIS PLAN IS/IS NOT GRANDFATHERED UNDER CB-27-2010, SECTION 25-117 (G).
- 10. TREE PRESERVATION AND RETENTION NOTES
- A. ALL WOODLANDS DESIGNATED ON THIS PLAN FOR PRESERVATION ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROPERTY OWNER. THE WOODLAND AREAS SHALL REMAIN IN A NATURAL STATE. THIS INCLUDES THE CANOPY TREES AND UNDERSTORY VEGETATION. A REVISED TREE CONSERVATION PLAN IS REQUIRED PRIOR TO CLEARING WOODLAND AREAS THAT ARE NOT SPECIFICALLY IDENTIFIED TO BE CLEARED ON THE APPROVED TCP2.
- B. TREE AND WOODLAND CONSERVATION METHODS SUCH AS ROOT PRUNING SHALL BE CONDUCTED AS NOTED ON THIS PLAN.
- C. THE LOCATION OF ALL TEMPORARY TREE PROTECTION FENCING (TPFS) SHOWN ON THIS PLAN SHALL BE FLAGGED OR STAKED IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO THE PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING. UPON APPROVAL OF THE LOCATIONS BY THE COUNTY INSPECTOR, INSTALLATION OF THE TPFS MAY BEGIN.
- D. ALL TEMPORARY TREE PROTECTION FENCING REQUIRED BY THIS PLAN SHALL BE INSTALLED PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF CLEARING AND GRADING OF THE SITE AND SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL THE BOND IS RELEASED FOR THE PROJECT. FAILURE TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN TEMPORARY OR PERMANENT TREE PROTECTIVE DEVICES IS A VIOLATION OF THIS TCP2.
- E. WOODLAND PRESERVATION AREAS SHALL BE POSTED WITH SIGNAGE AS SHOWN ON THE PLANS AT THE SAME TIME AS THE TEMPORARY TPF INSTALLATION. THESE SIGNS MUST REMAIN IN PERPETUITY.
- 11. REMOVAL OF HAZARDOUS TREES OR LIMBS BY DEVELOPERS OR BUILDERS
- A. THE DEVELOPER AND/OR BUILDER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETE PRESERVATION OF ALL FORESTED AREAS SHOWN ON THE APPROVED PLAN TO REMAIN UNDISTURBED. ONLY TREES OR PARTS THEREOF DESIGNATED BY THE COUNTY AS DEAD, DYING, OR HAZARDOUS MAY BE REMOVED.
- B. A TREE IS CONSIDERED HAZARDOUS IF A CONDITION IS PRESENT WHICH LEADS A CFRTIFIED ARBORIST OR LICENSED TREE EXPERT TO BELIEVE THAT THE TREE OR A PORTION OF THE TREE HAS A POTENTIAL TO FALL AND STRIKE A STRUCTURE, PARKING AREA, OR OTHER HIGH USE AREA AND RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE.
- C. DURING THE INITIAL STAGES OF CLEARING AND GRADING, IF HAZARDOUS TREES ARE PRESENT, OR TREES ARE PRESENT THAT ARE NOT HAZARDOUS BUT ARE LEANING INTO THE DISTURBED AREA. THE PERMITTEE SHALL REMOVE SAID TREES USING A CHAIN SAW. CORRECTIVE MEASURES REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF THE HAZARDOUS TREE OR PORTIONS THEREOF SHALL REQUIRE AUTHORIZATION BY THE COUNTY INSPECTOR, ONLY AFTER APPROVAL BY THE INSPECTOR MAY THE TREE BE CUT BY CHAINSAW TO NEAR THE EXISTING GROUND LEVEL. THE STUMP SHALL NOT BE REMOVED OR COVERED WITH SOIL, MULCH OR OTHER MATERIALS THAT WOULD INHIBIT SPROUTING.
- D. IF A TREE OR TREES BECOME HAZARDOUS PRIOR TO BOND RELEASE FOR THE PROJECT, DUE TO STORM EVENTS OR OTHER SITUATIONS NOT RESULTING FROM AN ACTION BY THE PERMITTEE, PRIOR TO REMOVAL, A CERTIFIED ARBORIST OR A LICENSED TREE EXPERT MUST CERTIFY THAT THE TREE OR THE PORTION OF THE TREE IN QUESTION HAS A POTENTIAL TO FALL AND STRIKE A STRUCTURE, PARKING AREA, OR OTHER HIGH USE AREA AND MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE. IF A TREE OR PORTIONS THEREOF ARE IN IMMINENT DANGER OF STRIKING A STRUCTURE, PARKING AREA, OR OTHER HIGH USE AREA AND MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE THEN THE CERTIFICATION IS NOT REQUIRED AND THE PERMITTEE SHALL TAKE
- CORRECTIVE ACTION IMMEDIATELY. THE CONDITION OF THE AREA SHALL BE FULLY DOCUMENTED THROUGH PHOTOGRAPHS PRIOR TO CORRECTIVE ACTION BEING TAKEN. THE PHOTOS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE INSPECTOR FOR DOCUMENTATION OF THE
- IF CORRECTIVE PRUNING MAY ALLEVIATE A HAZARDOUS CONDITION, THE CERTIFIED ARBORIST OR A LICENSED TREE EXPERT MAY PROCEED WITHOUT FURTHER AUTHORIZATION. THE PRUNING MUST BE DONE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST EDITION OF THE APPROPRIATE ANSI A-300 PRUNING STANDARDS. THE CONDITION OF THE AREA SHALL BE FULLY DOCUMENTED THROUGH PHOTOGRAPHS PRIOR TO CORRECTIVE ACTION BEING TAKEN. THE PHOTOS SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE INSPECTOR FOR DOCUMENTATION OF THE DAMAGE.
- DEBRIS FROM THE TREE REMOVAL OR PRUNING THAT OCCURS WITHIN 35 FEET OF THE WOODLAND EDGE MAY BE REMOVED AND PROPERLY DISPOSED OF BY RECYCLING, CHIPPING OR OTHER ACCEPTABLE METHODS. ALL DEBRIS THAT IS MORE THAN 35 FEET FROM THE WOODLAND EDGE SHALL BE CUT UP TO ALLOW CONTACT WITH THE GROUND, THUS ENCOURAGING DECOMPOSITION. THE SMALLER MATERIALS SHALL BE PLACED INTO BRUSH PILES THAT WILL SERVE AS WILDLIFE HABITAT.
- TREE WORK TO BE COMPLETED WITHIN A ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY REQUIRES A PERMIT FROM THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES UNLESS THE TREE REMOVAL IS SHOWN WITHIN THE APPROVED LIMITS OF DISTURBANCE ON A TCP2. THE WORK IS REQUIRED TO BE CONDUCTED BY A LICENSED TREE EXPERT.

- 12. TREE PROTECTION FENCING (TPFS) IS NOT REQUIRED FOR ALL OR PORTIONS OF THIS PLAN BECAUSE AN UNDISTURBED 100-FOOT BUFFER OF OPEN LAND /OR A 50-FOOT FORESTED BUFFER IS BEING MAINTAINED BETWEEN THE LIMIT OF DISTURBANCE (LOD) AND THE WOODLAND PRESERVATION AREAS. IF THE LOD CHANGES AND THE CHANGE IMPACTS THESE BUFFERS, THE COUNTY INSPECTOR SHALL BE CONTACTED TO EVALUATE THE CHANGE TO DETERMINE IF A REVISION TO THE TREE CONSERVATION PLAN IS NECESSARY OR IF INSTALLATION OF TPFS WILL BE REQUIRED.
- 13. WOODLAND PRESERVED, PLANTED OR REGENERATED IN FULFILLMENT OF THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION REQUIREMENTS ONSITE HAVE BEEN PLACED IN A WOODLAND AND WILDLIFE HABITAT CONSERVATION EASEMENT RECORDED IN THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY LAND RECORDS AT LIBER36703FOLIO 386 REVISIONS TO THIS TCP2 MAY REQUIRE A REVISED TO THE RECORDED EASEMENT. FOR THIS PROJECT 2.1 ACRES OF EXISTING FOREST WILL BE RETAINED IN AN EASEMENT. FOREST AREAS RETAINED OUTSIDE THE EASEMENTS MAY BE CLEARED BY FUTURE DEVELOPMENT WITHOUT INCURRING ADDITIONAL WOODLAND CONSERVATION OBLIGATION.

TCP 2 SITE NOTES

- 1. THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION OBLIGATION FOR THIS PROJECT WILL BE MET THROUGH 2.1 ACRES OF ONSITE FOREST RETENTION. THE BREAK-EVEN POINT FOR THE PROJECT IS 1.85 ACRES. FOREST NOT RETAINED IN A WOODLAND PRESERVATION AREA WILL NOT BE SUBJECT TO RETENTION REQUIREMENTS.
- 2. FOREST AREAS WITHIN THE EXISTING UTILITY RIGHT OF WAY AND ADJACENT 20 FOOT CONSTRUCTION STRIP ARE NOT COUNTED TOWARD THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION OBLIGATION.




