As discussed, there are two existing trees on Lot 13 that were saved during the initial stages of clearing at the above referenced property. At the direction of Mr. Brown & Mr. Hylton, I respectfully request authorization to remove the two referenced trees.

The Tulip Poplar, closest to the road, has died and has started dropping large limbs. The White Oak is too close to the house under construction and has poor branching structure. There are no limbs on the road side and all of the limbs are overhanging the house. In the future, the tree will pose a significant risk to the home.
