

REMOVAL OF HAZARDOUS TREES OR LIMBS by developers or builders 1. THE DEVELOPER AND/OR BUILDER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMPLETE PRESERVATION OF ALL FORESTED AREAS SHOWN ON THE APPROVED PLAN TO REMAIN UNDISTURBED. ONLY TREES OR PARTS THEREOF DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES AS DEAD, DYING, OR HAZARDOUS MAY BE REMOVED.

2. CORRECTIVE MEASURES REQUIRING THE REMOVAL OF THE HAZARDOUS TREE OR PORTIONS THEREOF SHALL REQUIRE AUTHORIZATION BY THE BUILDING OR GRADING INSPECTOR IF THERE IS A VALID GRADING OR BUILDING PERMIT FOR THE SUBJECT LOTS OR PARCELS ON WHICH THE TREES ARE LOCATED. ONLY AFTER APPROVAL OF THE APPROPRIATE INSPECTOR MAY THE TREE BE CUT BY CHAINSAW TO NEAR THE EXISTING GROUND LEVEL. THE STUMP MAY NOT BE REMOVED OR COVERED WITH SOIL, MULCH OR OTHER MATERIALS THAT WOULD INHIBIT SPROUTING.

FOREST RETENTION

WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS WILL BE DELINEATED WITH HIGH VISIBILITY FENCING AND TEMPORARY SIGNAGE AS SPECIFIED (SEE TREE PRPTECTION FENCE AND TEMPORARY SIGNAGE DETAILS) PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES OCCURRING ADJACENT TO THESE AREAS. FENCING SHALL NOT BE CONSIDERED INSTALLED CORRECTLY UNTIL REVIEWED BY A LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT RO QUALIFIED NATURAL RESOURCE PRFESSIONAL FAMILIAR WITH THE PLAN. ATTACHMENT OF SIGNS TO TREES IS PROHIBITED

PRECONSTRUCTION MEETING/CONSTRUCTION PERIOD PRACTICES


- I. THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES (DER) MUST BE CONTACTED PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY WORK ON THE SITE TO ADDRESS IMPLEMENTATION OF TREE CONSERVATION MEASURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN.
- 2. ALL APPROPSRIATE BONDS WILL BE POSTED WITH THE BUILDING OFFICIAL PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMITS. THESE BONDS WILL BE RETAINED AS SURETY BY THE BUILDING OFFICIAL UNTIL ALL REQUIRED ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN
- 3. THE LOCATION OF ALL TREE PROTECTION DEVICES (TPD) SHOWN ON THIS PLAN SHALL BE FLAGGED OR STAKED IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO THE PRE-CONSTRUCTION MEETING WITH THE SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL INSPECTOR FROM DER. UPON APPROVAL OF THE FLAGGED OR STAKED TPD LOCATIONS BY THE INSPECTOR, INSTALLATION OF THE TPDS MAY BEGIN. TPD INSTALLATION SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO THE INSTALLATION OF THE INITIAL SEDIMENT CONTROLS. NO CUTTING OR CLEARING OF TREES MAY BEGIN BEFORE FINAL APPROVAL OF TPD INSTALLATION.
- 4. WOODLAND CONSERVATION-TREE SAVE AREAS SHALL BE POSTED AS SHOWN AT THE SAME TIME AS THE TREE PROTECTIVE DEVICE INSTALLATION. THESE SIGNS SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE.
- 5. NO GRADING, EXCAVATION, UTILITY PLACEMENT, SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL DEVICES, OR VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WILL occur within woodland conservation areas.
- 6. STORAGE OF EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS.
- 7. THERE WILL BE NO BURIAL OR DISPOSAL OF DISCARDED MATERIAL ON SITE WITHIN THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION
- 8. THERE WILL BE NO OPEN BURNING WITHIN 100 FEET OF WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS.


10. EMPLOYEE PARKING SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS


9. TEMPORARY STRUCTURES INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO CONSTRUCTION TRAILERS, SANITARY FACILITIES, ETC. SHALL NOT BE PLACED WITHIN THE WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS.

TYPE II TREE CONSERVATION PLAN NOTES

- I. CUTTING OR CLEARING OF WOODLAND NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THIS PLAN OR WITHOUT THE EXPRESSED WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE PLANNING DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A \$1.50 PER SQUARE FOOT MITIGATION FEE, III REPLACEMENT OF THE DISTURBED WOODLANDS AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS THAT MAY BE REQUIRED DUE TO THE ? . I, 2:1 OR 1:1 REPLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CLEARING OF WOODLANDS.
- 2. THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES (DER) SHALL BE CONTACTED PRIOR TO THE START OF ANY WORK ON THE SITE TO ADDRESS IMPLEMENTATION OF WOODLAND CONSERVATION MEASURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAN.
- 3. PROPERTY OWNERS SHALL BE NOTIFIED BY THE DEVELOPER OR CONTRACTOR OF ANY WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS (TREE SAVE AREAS, REFORESTATION AREAS, AFFORESTATION AREAS, OR SELECTIVE CLEARING AREAS) LOCATED ON THEIR LOT OR PARCEL OF LAND AND THE ASSOCIATED FINES FOR UNAUTHORIZED DISTURBANCES TO THESE AREAS. UPON THE SALE OF THE PROPERTY THE OWNER / DEVELOPER OR OWNERS REPRESENTATIVE SHALL NOTIFY THE PURCHASER OF THE PROPERTY OF ANY WOODLAND CONSERVATION AREAS.
- 4. ALL REQUIRED OFF-SITE MITIGATION SHALL BE IDENTIFIED ON AN APPROVED TOPII FOR THE OFF-SITE LOCATION AND SHALL BE RECORDED AS AN OFF-SITE EASSEMENT IN THE LAND RECORDS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY (OR OTHER PROTECTION DOCUMENTS AS FOUND ACCEPTABLE BY THE M-NCPPC ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING SECTION (EPS)) FRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMITS FOR THE
- 5. ALL TREE PLANTING FOR WOODLAND REPLACEMENT, REFORESTATION OR AFFORESTATION WILL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO USE AND OCCUPANCY PERMIT. FAILURE TO ESTABLISH THE WOODLAND REPLACEMENT, REFORESTATION OR AFFORESTATION WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED TIME FRAME WILL RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF THE REFORESTATION BOND AND/OR A VIOLATION OF THIS PLAN INCLUDING THE ASSOCIATED \$1.50 PER SQUARE FOOT PENALTY UNLESS A WRITTEN EXTENSION IS APPROVED BY THE DER INSPECTOR.
- 6. THE DER INSPECTOR SHALL BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO SOIL PREPARATION OR INITIATION OF ANY TREE PLANTING ON THIS SITE.
- 7. RESULTS OF SURVIVAL CHECKS FOR ALL TREE PLANTINGS SHALL BE REPORTED TO THE DER INSPECTOR FOR THE SITE AND M-NCPPC, ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING SECTION.
- 8. A REFORESTATION BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$0.30 PER S.F. WILL BE POSTED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMITS FOR AN AREA IMPACTED BY THAT PERMIT OR TO SATISFY OFF-SITE REFORESTATION REQUIREMENTS.
- 9. PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMITS THE CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBLE FOR SOIL PREPARATION, SITE PREPARATION, TREE PLAINTING AND TREE MAINTENANCE MUST BE IDENTIFIED. NAME TO BE DETERMINED








Forest Retention Area Signage

1. BOTTOM OF SIGNS TO BE 5'+/- ABOVE FINISHED GRADE OR ATTACHED TO THE PERMANENT TREE PROTECTION FENCE WITH 2. SIGN TO BE ATTACHED TO A 2" (MIN.) STEEL U-CHANNEL POST OR AT LEAST 3"X3" TIMBER WITH A MINIMUM 6" IN LENGTH. THE POST SHALL BE SUNK INTO THE GROUND TO A DEPTH OF AT LEAST 1/3 ITS 3. SIGNS TO PLACED APPROXIMATELY 50' APART. SITE CONDITIONS AFFECTING VISIBILITY MAY WARRANT PLACING SIGNS CLOSER OR FARTHER APART. 4. ATTACHMENT OF SIGNS TO TREES IS PROHIBITTED.

TREE PROTECTION DEVICES THE TPD SHALL BE PLACED AS INDICATED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SITE DEVELOPMENT PROCESS. SIGNAGE SHALL BE PLACED ON THE FENCE POSTS TO INDICATE A FOREST RETENTION AREA. THESE FENCES AND SIGNS SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANAGEMENT PLAN INCLUDED ON THIS PLAN OR UNTIL APPROVAL IS GIVEN BY THE PG COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNING SECTION TO REMOVE THEM.
